Boston Partnership Fund Refurbishment


Firstly, we would like to express our gratitude to the Government and the Boston Borough Council who have awarded us £184,000 from the Boston Partnership Fund. This money aims to go towards improving and refreshing changes made to the centre that will benefit all users present and future. These projects include the following, disabled toilet relocation, toilet upgrades, solar panel installation, new reception roof, fencing and more.

In terms of our recent progress with regards to the refurb the installation of the new disabled has already started and is nearing completion. The contractors next task will then move towards upgrading both the male and female toilets upstairs and start the new cleaning cupboard with all new fixture and fittings.

We are also excited to announce that local electricians have started to place solar panels on the roof of the building to make the centre more energy efficient, in total their will be 20 solar panels being installed on the roof.

Also this month we are glad to announce that the planning permission for the outdoor projects such as the fencing and new reception roof has started being processed.
