## October's Monthly Newsletter

Welcome to our newsletter! We are thrilled to share with you the latest developments in our mission to make a positive impact in our community.

### Boston Partnership Fund Refurbishment

Regarding our recent refurbishment updates, the cleaning cupboard, disabled toilet, and upstairs toilets have now been completed, with only a few minor finishing touches remaining. These areas are now fully operational, and the plumbing team has subsequently began work on the downstairs toilets, where good progress is being made.

With regards to the solar panels, now all of the panels have been successfully installed on the roof the process of the internal wiring for the panels to work efficiently has been progressing through out recent weeks. This is including adding a battery storage system, which will store excess energy generate by the solar panels during the day, so it can be used at night or during power outages. This battery storage will be located outside on the back of the centre in a secure frame.

We received news from the council that the planning application which we submitted back in early August 2025 has now been fully approved by the council. Meaning we can now move forwards with regards to installing fencing at the rear of the centre, giving the exterior of the building a new look with a fresh coat of paint and installing a new bike rack at the front of the centre to encourage a greener way of commuting. We have also just started to paint the main corridors on the ground floor of the building, this will be continued also in the main corridors upstairs to create a more vibrant and welcoming working space for both staff and service users.

Other projects will be due to take place within in the centre in the coming weeks such as the erection of fencing at the back of the centre which will start on Monday 3rd November 2025. Also, all new interior blinds are to be fitted in coming weeks to all windows on the ground floor.
